



Q. What is Harger University?

A: Harger University is a training center located at 301 Ziegler Drive, Grayslake, IL 60030.

Q. What is offered in the Lightning Protection Installation Course?

A: Taught by industry experts, this training is offered to electrical contractors, engineers, or anyone who wants to learn how to perform their own installations. The course covers lightning protection design and installation requirements compliant with the nationally recognized standards NFPA 780 and UL 96A. It also describes the UL Master Label process and how by working with Harger, one can successfully install listed lightning protection systems. Harger has successfully designed, supervised, and installed UL Master Label Systems and is uniquely qualified to help others learn this process.

Q. Are there any costs for the course?

A: There is no charge to attend and all training materials are FREE. Attendees are responsible for their own travel to and from the training and their own lodging expenses.

Q. How long is the course?

A: The course is taught over a 2 day period. Day One starts at 1pm and ends by 5pm. Day Two starts at 8am and ends by 5pm.

Q. When is the course offered?

A: The course is offered once a month starting in February and ending in November. Each class holds up to 20 people. Availability is first come, first served. The monthly registration schedule is posted online early in the year for advanced planning.

Q. Is this a CEC approved course?

A: Yes! The course is approved by BICSI and by many states. Electrical contractors licensed in those states will receive continuing education hours/credits towards their electrical license. Q. Is special insurance needed to install lightning protection equipment?

A: No, additional insurance is not needed to offer this service.

Q. What support can be expected after the course is over?

A: Harger's support includes: Material Estimates, Full Submittals, On-Site Pre-Installation Meetings, Technical Support, Post-Installation Inspections, and UL Certification.

Q. Will I be UL certified after I take the course?

A: People do not become certified by UL, only jobs can become certified. After attending the course, one will have a full understanding on what and who is certified and listed.

Q. What airport should I fly into to attend?

A: Fly into Chicago O'Hare International Airport (about 45 minutes South of Harger) or General Mitchell International Airport in Milwaukee, Wisconsin (about 1 hr. North of Harger).

Q. What hotel should I stay at?
